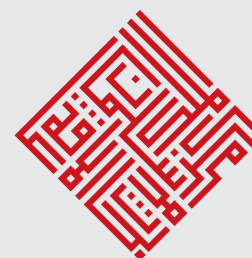

In a dialogue session within the second day of the 6th International Conference for Disability and Rehabilitation

Prince Sultan bin Salman stresses the importance of "daring towards the future" in dealing with the disability

His Royal Highness Prince Sultan bin Salman stressed the importance of "daring towards the future" in dealing with the disability file, during the dialogue session he chaired this afternoon, Monday, within the second day of the 6th International Conference on Disability and Rehabilitation, entitled "Foreseeing the Future", in the presence of a number of senior officials, specialists and researchers who participated in the conference, including His Excellency Dr. Munir bin Mahmoud El-Dasouki, President of King Abdulaziz City for Science and Technology, Dr. Tarif bin Yusuf Al-A'ma, Undersecretary of the Ministry of Health, Dr. Hisham bin Mohammed Al-Haidari, the Executive Head of the Authority for the Care of Persons with Disabilities, and a number of international researchers and specialists.

The session was initiated by HRH Prince Sultan bin Salman, who emphasized the concept of daring and its importance in considering and planning for the future, and that this is the policy of the country that it has adopted since its inception. HRH also stressed the need to achieve success in serving the issue of disability during the next five years, because everything is prepared for success.

For his part, Dr. Munir bin Mahmoud El-Dasouki, President of King Abdulaziz City for Science and Technology, congratulated the center's team on this wonderful conference, and explained that there is huge growth in this sector in many ways, for example, more than a billion people around the world benefit from some sort of



assistant technology, and we expected this may double up to two billion, and this poses a huge opportunity for innovation for the world in the near future. Meanwhile, Dr. Tarif bin Yusuf Al-A'ma, Undersecretary of the Ministry of Health, stressed the responsibility of the Ministry of Health to ensure coverage and guarantee the quality of life in all stages of disability.

Dr. Cuntai Guan from Nanyang Technology University and one of the winners of the King Salman International Award for Disability Research stressed that the application of artificial intelligence has just started in the field of healthcare. Dr. Guan added: "We have seen a lot of successful applications and

analyzes in hospital management, and there are many potential requirements for use of artificial intelligence, and we need to form the data collected from homes combined with hospital data and behavioral data". For his part, Dr. Edward Cupler, Neuroscientist at King Faisal Specialist Hospital, indicated the need to pay attention to restorative therapy and technology to improve people's quality of life.

The second day of the conference continued, as three main sessions and three workshops were held, in which researchers and disability specialists from inside and outside the Kingdom participated.

Unique International Award

His Excellency Dr. Tawfiq bin Fawzan Al-Rabiah, Minister of Hajj, and Chairman of the Award Authority of King Salman International Award for Disability Research stressed that the volume of attention received by people with disabilities in the Kingdom enhances the state's strategy towards continuing to empower and integrate people with disabilities and embodies the interest in searching for more achievements that serve their issue. He also explained that this award is one of the most accurate international awards in the field of disability in terms of standards and clarity in the method of evaluation, as well as its financial value is the highest in the world among similar awards.

This came during a dialogue that took place with him on the sidelines of the 6th International Conference on Disability and Rehabilitation, which will be held under the patronage of the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques King Salman bin Abdulaziz and organized by the King Salman Center for Disability Research during the period from 4-6 December at Alfaisal University in Riyadh.

In your capacity as Chairman of Award Authority of the King Salman International Award for Disability Research, how do you assess the global interest in it, as the 3rd session kicks off

- great interest accorded to disability issues and persons with disabilities in our country by our leadership since its establishment at the hands of the founder, the late King Abdulaziz bin Abdulrahman Al-Faisal Al Saud until our prosperous era, the era of the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques King Salman bin Abdulaziz Al Saud, and His Royal Highness Prince Mohammed bin Salman bin Abdulaziz Al Saud, the Crown Prince, is a source of pride for all the people of the country, and this was evident in the efforts made by all government agencies and civil society institutions throughout the Kingdom. The award is honored to bear the name of the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques King Salman bin Abdulaziz Al Saud, and it is the only global award in this field that bears the name of a leader and president of a country the size of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. Perhaps the increasing demand by researchers and senior scientists in this field is evidence of the award's global standing, and its success in achieving its desired goal, which is to confront the issue of disability in all its categories and continue to empower and integrate people with disabilities and embody interest in searching for more achievements that serve their cause.

*** This year, the award witnessed a significant increase in the number of candidates, reaching 370 nominees from 46 countries; How does Your Excellency see this increasing turnout, and what are the criteria of Scientific Committee to evaluate the winners of the award?**

- There is no doubt that this number is an addition and success to the International Award, and the report of the General Secretariat of the Award indicated that the Award in its third session recorded a large number, and this gives excellent indicators of the size of turnout and interaction and the importance of the Award in advancing scientific research for disability, being one of the most international awards in the fields of disability accuracy in the level of standards, and clear in the method of evaluation, and



financially, the size of the award is the largest in the field of disability, and therefore researchers from 42 countries participated in the first session, and in the second session researchers from 29 countries, and in this third edition the Scientific Committee of the award added two new branches of technologies and universal access, and the number in the field of universal access reached (15) in the branch of health and medical sciences (42) candidates, in the branch of educational and psychological sciences 28 candidates, and in the branch of applications of

technology in the field of disability (31) candidates. the Scientific Committee has held 13 meetings during the first six months after the announcement of the opening of the nomination for the branches of the award, to select the winners very carefully.

*** How does your Excellency assess the interest of the King Salman Center for Disability Research in scientific research?**

- Advanced scientific research is of paramount importance to any medical institution, and the King Salman Center for Disability Research, which stands at the top of its administration, His Royal Highness Prince Sultan bin Salman bin Abdulaziz, Advisor to the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques, gives scientific research great importance, and the directives of HRH always stress the need to keep pace with scientific research for the rehabilitation and educational services provided to children with disabilities. The center has worked since its inception on specialized scientific programs that all serve the issue of disability and persons with disabilities, and the center has also worked with many international scientific centers in the fields of advanced scientific research and implemented many projects and programs that were applied on the ground, including the universal access program, which has achieved great success since its inception.

Within the 6th International Conference on Disability and Rehabilitation Prince Sultan bin Salman Signs Five Initiatives, Cooperation Agreements with Group of National Educational Authorities



His Royal Highness Prince Sultan bin Salman, Special Adviser to the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques and Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the King Salman Center for Disability and Research, signed five initiatives and cooperation agreements with a group of national educational bodies This came on the sidelines of the 6th International Conference on Disability and Rehabilitation, taking place under the patronage of the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques King Salman bin Abdulaziz from 4-6 December in Princess Haya Auditorium at Alfaisal University in Riyadh.

The initiatives and agreements signed by HRH Prince Sultan include memorandums of cooperation between the King Salman Center for Disability Research on one hand, and the Tatweer Education Technologies Company (TETCO), Imam Mohammed bin Saud Islamic University, the Saudi Electronic University, and Taibah University on the other hand. The memorandums aim to achieve joint cooperation among all parties and unifying efforts in the various fields of disability such as education, awareness, training, scientific and technical research specialized in the field of disability,



according to the competence of each of the parties, as stipulated in the memorandums of cooperation.

King Salman Center for Disability Research also signed a memorandum of cooperation with Prince Sultan University with the aim of supporting research, development and production of artificial limbs using modern technologies, production of medical splints, and participation in training programs, skills development courses, studies and research organized by the two parties. Its worth noting that these initiatives and

cooperation agreements come within the framework of its efforts of the Center and the Chairman of its Board of Trustees, HRH Prince Sultan bin Salman, to consolidate and strengthen the relationship with various educational and research agencies, in order to contribute to enriching the scientific and research efforts of the Center and advance its outputs to serve the issue of disability and lead to improve the quality of life of people with disabilities, and the 6th International Conference on Disability and Rehabilitation is one of these efforts.

6th International Conference for Disability and Rehabilitation Gains Growing Momentum in Scientific and Health Events

On behalf of the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques King Salman bin Abdulaziz, HRH Prince Faisal bin Bandar bin Abdulaziz, Governor of Riyadh Region, and HRH Prince Sultan bin Salman bin Abdulaziz, Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the King Salman Center for Disability Research, inaugurate the 6th international Conference for Disability and Rehabilitation, amid growing momentum in events, attendance and initiatives, as reflected in the figures and statistics recently announced by King Salman Center for Disability Research.

According to figures and statistics recently announced by King Salman Center for Disability Research, the Conference, which will be held from 4 to 6 of December at Alfaisal University in Riyadh, will see wide local, Arab, and international participation, representing 27 various countries. The figures also indicate that there is a demand for registration to attend the conference from inside and outside the Kingdom, while registered persons from the Kingdom have reached 2015 participants, and the number of registered people from outside the Kingdom have reached 560 participants, who varied between doctors, specialists, and researchers in the field of disability, in addition to interested people.

Also, the figures announced by the Center indicated that there is momentum from the entities and individuals supporting the conference as well as volunteers. The number of entities supporting the conference reached 18 entities that varied between ministries, health and educational institutions, banks and various companies, and the number of individual volunteers during the conference have

reached 146 volunteers so far, and it's expected that this number will increase in the coming days, which indicates the high awareness of the importance of the disability issue and activities that serve it, as indicated by the Chairman of the Preparatory Committee for the Conference and the Secretary-General of the Center, Dr. Ahmad bin Abdulaziz Al-Tamimi.

Dr. Al-Tamimi added that the conference is witnessing a different kind of momentum, represented in the number of initiatives and cooperation agreements between King Salman Center for Disability Research and other competent and interested Authorities, which has reached 19 initiative that will be announced in the initiatives platform in the conference and four cooperation agreements, of which a number of initiatives with Authority of People with Disability, and King Abdulaziz City for Science and Technology, which includes the launch of a global business accelerator specialized in disability research. Also, an agreement with Tatweer Educational Technologies Company to develop means and fields of research, studies and technical projects related to disability, and an agreement with Imam Mohammad ibn Saud Islamic University to develop the quality of scientific research, and others. The conference is also witnessing a momentum of the trainee numbers attending the events, which reached 512 trainees, at a time when the Saudi Commission for Health Specialties has approved 14 medical hours for the conference, and during the conference 16 workshops will be



organized and presented by 22 specialists in four auditoriums. Seven organizing committees, with a membership of 81 members, participate in organizing the activities of the conference. The conference is witnessing the participation of 19 senior invitees and speakers, including international speakers such as the President of the World Federation of the Deaf and Secretary General of the International Disability Alliance, Dr. Joseph Murray; Member of Direction of the European Union of the Deaf,

Humberto Insolera; and the Director of the Duke Center for Autism and Brain Development in the United States, Dr. Geraldine Dawson, and number of Saudi and Arab speakers such as Professor Majid Al Fadhel, Deputy Executive Director at the King Abdullah International Medical Research Center; Dr. Mohammed Aldosari, Director of the Center for Pediatric Neuroscience at the Cleveland Clinic Foundation, Ohio, and Dr. Yasmin Al-Tuwaijri, first Saudi female physician and biologist, and others.
