

why I was excited to go to Umluj.


















I could only think about dolphins during breakfast.

I prefer being in the ocean because loud noises bother me.






The waves weren't high anymore. As I stared into the distance, I couldn't believe my eyes.



### WHAT IS AUTISM?

Autism spectrum disorder (ASD) is a Developmental Disorder that characterised by impairments in social, communication, and behaviour challenges and a restricted and repetitive repertoire of interests and activities.

### CHARACTERISTICS OF AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDERS

- Individuals with ASD have social communication challenges including verbal and nonverbal communication.
- Individuals with ASD may have deficit in social interaction.
- Individuals with ASD might have restricted, repetitive behaviours and unusual interest in objects.

### **FACT ABOUT INDIVIDUALS WITH AUTISM:**

- Even though Autism is a lifelong disorder, but individuals with ASD can be get effective intervention that help them overcome their challenges.
- Changes in familiar activities, places or people can be stressful for individuals with ASD.
- Individuals with ASD may have great ability in one area and great difficulty in another. For example: they may have an extremely good memory and being detailed orientated.
- Individuals with ASD may have unusually strong reactions to one or more of their five senses.
- They do not look different than anyone else but they think, performance and talk differently.
- Autism can occur in any cultural and ethnic group, as well as across all socioeconomic levels.
- There are no two individuals with ASD are the same,
   and each individual with ASD has a combination of strengths,
   difficulties, and interests that make them unique.

## AUTISTIC PEOPLE OFTEN HAVE OTHER CONDITIONS, LIKE:

- Attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD).
- · Anxiety or depression.
- Epilepsy.

Two: Conducting and facilitating training events related to the scientific aspects of disability.


**Three:** Releasing periodicals publishing research papers and studies related to disability.
